

Motivation letter

My name is Duniel Ortuño, a Chilean dentist. Through this letter, I would like to introduce myself to you and express my most sincere motivation to be part of the Public Health Committee of the World Dental Federation. I am currently a member of the Public Health and International Relations departments of the College of Dental Surgeons of Chile, so I am grateful for the nomination to assume this vacancy. In addition, I am president of the Chilean Society of Oral Public Health and a member of the IADR Chilean Division.

Since 2015, the year I graduated as a dentist, I have been linked to Public Health. I have been an academic at two universities in the country, exclusively in the Public Health and Epidemiology areas. I studied at the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile in the Master's and Doctorate programs in Epidemiology. Additionally, I have worked in dental programs in primary health care in Santiago de Chile, been an advisor to the Ministry of Health, and been part of TEPHINET-CDC. I have written manuscripts, all in Public Health, which have been published in national and international journals. I have participated in implementing oral health plans and programs in Chile, in addition to developing clinical practice guidelines.
