I believe the increasing demand in the field of public health necessitates a well-planned and positive response from communities. Oral health is no exception, especially as it is one of the most neglected areas of health.

The FDI World Dental Federation is the key global institution that must address this need.

My main motivation for joining the FDI Public Health Committee is to advocate for oral health as a universal health right.

From the beginning of my journey as a health student, my purpose has been to help people live healthier lives by addressing the real factors that contribute to poor health. Advocacy for equitable medicine and dentistry has always been my mission.

In 2005, I founded the non-governmental organization "Mundo-a-Sorrir" (Smiling World). Our initial projects were in Cape Verde and Guinea-Bissau. Since then, our initiatives have expanded, improving public health in several underserved communities, including those in Portugal. This 15-year experience has equipped me with the skills to demonstrate that NGOs can effectively collaborate with the United Nations, making it more feasible to enhance the health conditions of populations.

As president of the Portuguese Dental Association, I have had the opportunity to influence health policies in my country. Two significant achievements include advocating for a dental career path within the National Health Service and establishing the specialty of Public Oral Health. In the field of health literacy, I promoted a didactic game for children, developed by OMD and Science4You, and initiated the project "Eat Well, Smile Better," aimed at improving children's health literacy. I also contributed to the report prepared by the Working Group "NHS Oral Health 2.0," which laid the groundwork for a public sector strategy to enhance oral health care access for the Portuguese population by 2026.

I hope to earn your support. As a future member of the Public Health Committee, I am committed to contributing my experience and objectives towards achieving better global oral health and promoting a healthier life worldwide.
