

**Dear Esteemed Colleagues:** 

The American Dental Association hereby seconds the nomination of Dr. Stephen Liew (Australia) as a 2024 Candidate for FDI Speaker of the General Assembly.

The FDI Constitution makes the following provisions for this matter:

Section 2.3: The Speaker shall be nominated by one or more of the Regular Members and elected by the General Assembly

Section 3.5: Each nomination must be supported by the nominee's Regular Member Association.

The American Dental Association is a Regular Member and therefore can nominate Dr. Liew, provided the Australian Dental Association submits his initial nomination. In effect, this nomination could be interpreted as a "seconding motion" if it were done verbally on the floor of the Congress.

To date, the American Dental Association has never co-nominated an individual from another National Dental Association but finds that this action is compliant with the FDI Constitution. If the Australian Dental Association does not put forth Dr. Liew's nomination, the American Dental Association's nomination will be rescinded.
