Personal Statement for FDI Council Position

I am writing to express my enthusiastic candidacy for the councilor position at the FDI World Dental Federation.

My journey with the FDI began seven years ago as a member of the Public Health Committee (PHC), culminating in my role as Chair for the last three years. This period has been one of profound growth, learning, and impactful service.

Coming from a forcibly displaced family, I have always been driven to serve marginalized and vulnerable populations, especially refugees. This commitment found its fullest expression in my leadership of the FDI Refugee Oral Health Project. The advocacy guide we created for promoting oral health among refugees became a valuable resource for many organizations. Between 2022 and 2024, we used this guide to advocate for refugee oral health locally, regionally, and globally. We supported dental associations in Bangladesh, Pakistan, and Palestine, collaborated with UNHCR Asia, and engaged with international organizations such as the UNHCR Global, the Lancet Coalition for Migration, the Framework Convention on Global Health Alliance, the Sustainable Health Equity Movement, and the World Federation of Public Health Associations.

During my tenure on the FDI Public Health Committee, I led the development of six key policy statements focused on improving access to oral health services for different marginalized populations, including mothers and young children. We emphasized primary prevention to minimize early childhood caries (ECC).

Guided by the FDI Vision 2030 and the WHO Strategy and Action Plan, we identified key areas to expand access to care by empowering the workforce to support oral health professionals. With the help of dedicated FDI staff and the involvement of 22 experts and 28 reviewers, we produced 19 facts aiming to equip other healthcare providers with basic knowledge and skills to identify oral diseases, refer patients to the dental team, and recognize the link between oral and systemic health.

In addition, my work on the PHC Tobacco Cessation project, co-coaching dentists in workshops on delivering brief tobacco cessation advice, was an eye-opening experience, highlighting the significant impact dentists can have on patient behavior and health.

On a research level, I am proud to have over 1,000 citations for my scientific publications on Google Scholar, spanning education, epidemiology, and access to dental care. I currently serve as the president

of the recently established IADR Palestinian section and a co-chair of the Women in Science Organization (OWSD) Palestine chapter.

My passion for justice, equity, professionalism, social responsibility, and community service drives my work. Currently, I serve on the steering committees of various international organizations, including TUG, the Danish Dental Health Without Borders, and VISTO International Organization for Rights and Development. In the last two years, I have chaired the Academic Network for Development Dialogue in the Arab Region (ANDD) and the Global Movement for Sustainable Health Equity (SHEM).

Academically, I serve as an Associate Professor of Dental Public Health at Al-Quds University (AQU) and head the Oral Health Research and Promotion Unit. I plan to continue empowering the next generation of dentists to fulfill their three essential roles: physicians diagnosing oral disease and addressing its causes, surgeons providing minimal and wise tissue repair, and advocates promoting oral health and addressing its social and commercial determinants.

It would be an honor to extend my service to FDI as a councilor. I am eager to continue contributing to our shared mission of promoting oral health globally and empowering oral health professionals locally and regionally through advocacy, knowledge transfer, and innovation. Working alongside dedicated staff and volunteering colleagues has been an invaluable experience, and I am committed to advancing our collective goals with passion and dedication.

Thank you for considering my application. I look forward to the opportunity to further serve the FDI and contribute to its vital initiatives.
