

Presentation

I believe that "Health" is a fundamental human right, for all humans regardless of caste, creed or gender. With this belief, I became Member of FDI Public Health Committee in 2021.

About 1.5 years back, the FDI Public Health Committee discussed the possibility of improving the Oral Health of Refugees in different parts of the world.

I informed that Pakistan has the largest number of Refugees in the world- the Afghan Refugees, and offered my services to undertake the **FDI Afghan Refugees Project in Pakistan.**

In September 2023 an official agreement was signed between FDI and myself as President of Pakistan Dental Association.

One year later, I am happy to report to this General Assembly that this **FDI AfghanRefugees Project** has been a resounding success. More than 2,500 Afghan Refugees and their families have been provided Dental Treatments, including;**Fillings, Scaling, Extractions, Root Canal Treatments, etc.** Since Afghanis were reluctant to send their womenfolk outside their settlement areas, hence treatment was provided in the settlement areas.

I usually visited the clinics fortnightly, and other dentists worked actively providing daily dental treatment. Dentists were paid monthly along with the cost of dental materials. Furthermore, Full Day Dental Camps/Survey were arranged 09 times in the last year.

The Afghans and their elders were extremely pleased and grateful to FDI for providing them free Dental Treatments.

One constant risk was Security of Dentists, which we overcame with love and affection and of course some Armed Deterrence. Police escorts were not welcome by the Afghanis in their settlement areas.

UNHCR has also been attracted towards this Project and want to join in, in the next phase, tentatively starting from October 2024. FDI is also interested to take this **Afghan Refugees Project** to the next level.

My humble suggestion for the next level is to train some young Afghan Refugees as Dental Auxiliaries and attach with local Dentists to facilitate Afghanis Oral Health Treatment indigenously after their one-year training is completed. If entrusted with the responsibility again, I shall strive to obtain even better outcomes on this and/or other projects given by FDI.
