Mick Armstrong BDA candidate for FDI Council 2025

My candidacy for the FDI Council is based on a sharp focus to move FDI forward in its goal to achieve optimal oral health by implementing Vision 2030 and achieving Universal Health Coverage (UHC) as per the World Health Organisation's (WHO) Global Strategy on Oral Health and Bangkok Declaration.

Some of what I say might be seen as controversial. For the avoidance of doubt, I wholeheartedly believe the leader of the dental team must be a dentist. But the key word here is "team'. If we are to move anywhere near achieving optimal oral health in the world, we will need to dramatically expand our teams, educating and regulating them properly and using their skills more imaginatively and more widely for the good of our patients.

This does not lead to an undermining of our status as dentists, as some might feel. If our role at the FDI is to lead the world to optimal oral health, then our leadership is both necessary and helpful to us in keeping and enhancing that status. If we do not do so, decisions are likely to be made without us.

It's easy to forget that. We are in love with our skillset and our status and that is understandable; but as the gap widens between those who can access quality dentistry and those who cannot, I think FDI needs to refocus in its work.

I have the relevant Board experience after 13 years on the BDA Board, chairing it for six years; I have also held the role of Treasurer on the Board of the Council of European Dentists (CED). I currently also chair a working group at the FDI's European Regional Organisation (ERO) on Oral Health and General Health. And I have chaired the FDI's Dental Practice Committee (DPC) until this year, and together with its dedicated members I have always sought to produce policy statements and papers that align with the FDI's Vision 2030.

But I believe there is a need to intensify this approach. So rather than develop an excellent Masterclass on high-end restorative techniques, why not a Masterclass on prevention? And we could further underline the FDI mission by having the Congress focus more strongly on dental public health and the roles and responsibilities of the dental team, rather than an emphasis on cosmetic dentistry which is unlikely to be available to the majority of the patients we are supposed to serve.

If elected I will work on the Council to ensure the FDI's vision retains its sharp focus on our primary objective.

I humbly ask for your vote.
