## Written Presentation: 2025 FDI Council

As dentists, we understand the connection between oral health and overall health and wellness. Poor oral health impacts every single aspect of one's life: the ability to chew, swallow, sleep, focus, learn, obtain and maintain employment, contribute to one's local community and the world at large. Oral health must be recognized as essential health care; a priority for every person who inhabits our world. Through the FDI World Dental Federation, dental associations around the globe work together to establish and maintain oral health care as essential health care. I have been honored to serve as a 5-year delegate to the General Assembly (2020-2025), and I would be honored to serve on FDI Council.

As a 35-year member of the American Dental Association (ADA), I appreciate the value of organized dentistry; it provides the avenue for dentists and dental associations to share and exchange ideas; to help promote policies and procedures that will improve the profession and practice of dentistry.
