Dear Members of the FDI Council,

'If you want to go fast, you go alone; If you want to go far, you go together.' That is my motto during my 30+ years service to dental public health with colleagues in Taiwan and in Asia-Pacific region.

I am Lin-Yang Chi, dedicated myself to dental public health ever since I got my DDS in Taiwan in 1986. With 2-year service experience in government, I went to the Cambridge University, UK, to get further education in Community Medicine and my PhD degree there. I taught Biostatistics and Epidemiology in the National Yang Ming Chiao Tung University (NYCU), where I served as a full-time faculty of Dentistry Department since 1997. To establish a National Oral Health Databank through standardized oral examinations is essential to effectively carry out any oral health promotion campaign, according to WHO. That is exactly what I have been working for during the past decade, together with my team at NYCU. I have worked as a consultant to the Department of Health and Welfare, Executive Yuan. I was the PI of 2 consecutive 5-year National Oral Health Promotion Projects (2016-2021, and 2022-2026). To encourage young medical/dental students to join public health, I also served as the mentor of the Yang-Ming Crusade Club of NYCU since 1999. Some of the students joined the Club then now serve as senior directors of public hospitals. It is my true pleasure to know there are more physicians/dentists to join the public health taskforce.

To facilitate international cooperation and exchanging expertise, I actively join meetings held by the APDF and FDI. I served as the Chairman of Public Health Commission of APDF during 2018-2021, which gave me the honor to know many public health dentists abroad. I had run for the Public Health Committee of FDI several times but not successfully. I would like to try again, hoping to get a chance to contribute to global oral health as well as bring new initiatives to people in Asia-Pacific Region.
